As a Recovery Practitioner, you will be providing harm reduction advice, and tailored individual and group interventions to support service users in achieving and maintaining recovery from the problematic use of alcohol and other substances. Most people using our service have experienced trauma, and our service offers them a safe and consistent environment in which they can heal from this, and to develop life skills and confidence.

People using our services need staff who are compassionate, empathetic, and kind. We value these qualities over knowledge about drugs and alcohol, so therefore we welcome candidates who do not have a background of working within the substance use field but possess transferable skills from other sectors. If you are passionate about helping others and want to join a team dedicated to making a positive impact, we want to hear from you! We can offer professional development and supervision, in a service that consistently receives excellent feedback from people who use it.

The ideal candidate will have a minimum of 3 years' experience, excellent communication skills, a compassionate and non-judgmental approach, and the ability to work effectively within a team.
